PARTICIPATORY DEMOCRACY

We have been working on...

- In February we settled the case of *Navajo Nation Human Rights Commission v. San Juan County*, after the county cut the number of polling places serving the Navajo Nation and failed to provide adequate language assistance; we are working to ensure they adhere to our settlement agreement;
- Supported the Better Boundaries initiative to gather enough signatures to place their redistricting initiative and successfully pass it, Proposition #4, on the 2018 November ballot;
- Lobbied successfully for a bill that: implemented a version of automatic voter registration that requires individuals who apply for or renew their driver's license to choose whether to also be registered to vote; reinstated election day registration as a permanent, state-wide law; and provided voters the option to cast a ballot in person.

Looking forward....

- Launching a social media awareness campaign with partners to advertise Election Day Registration
- Monitoring the November elections, especially in San Juan County to ensure fair and open access to the polls
- Know Your Rights workshops for protestors and legal observers to promote compliance with First Amendment rights

Voting rights are under attack nationwide as states attempt to pass voter suppression laws. These laws lead to significant burdens for eligible voters trying to exercise a fundamental constitutional right. Since 2008, states across the country have passed measures to make it harder for Americans—particularly black people, the elderly, students, and people with disabilities—to exercise their fundamental right to cast a ballot.

These measures include cuts to early voting days, voter ID laws, proof of citizenship requirements, limits of voter registration drives, and purges of voter rolls. The ACLU is engaged in advocacy and litigation across the country to remove these harmful voter suppression measures once and for all.
