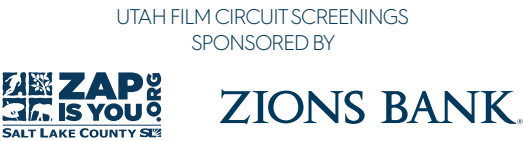
About the film
