**RE: RE: APPEAL OF DENIAL OF GRAMA REQUEST**

Dear Mr. Edwards and Mayor Lee,

On November 6, 2002, I made a request under the Government Records Access and Management Act (GRAMA), Ut. Code Ann. §§63-2-101 et seq. (1953 as amended) to the City of Virgin.

Representing Virgin, Mr. Edwards repeatedly assured me that his client's answer to the GRAMA request was on its way, forestalling legal action on our first appeal of your failure to answer the original GRAMA request. However, to date I have not received any response to the request. That constitutes a denial.

This letter is an appeal of that denial. This appeal is made pursuant to Ut. Code Ann. §63-2-401 (1953 as amended) and/or the applicable rules and ordinances. You have a five-day statutory time period to respond to this appeal. If you do not, the ACLU of Utah will pursue further legal action. If you are not the appropriate officer to receive and consider this appeal, please immediately notify me and immediately forward this appeal to the appropriate officer.
