


Carlos




Eduardo

"I am glad to stand with my family against the way we were treated by the agents. We had done nothing wrong, and yet they acted like we were criminals. They even put me in handcuffs so tightly I had marks on my wrists for a month. They made fun of us for being afraid of their guns. They came two days

in a row, many of them, armed with assault weapons. None of us caused any problems for them, and they knew there were kids in the apartment. No one should have to go through what we did."

"Without showing us any warrant, the agents came into our homes, asked us questions, told us we couldn't talk to one another or talk to our kids, and pointed weapons at us. We went along with everything they asked, but they still made fun of us and treated us badly. The kids are so scared now of policemen, and our family had to move."

"I am glad we have filed this lawsuit today. The raids made us feel unsafe in our own home. Agents burst into my apartment twice, once using a battering ram in the middle of the night to burst in on me and my three babies who were sleeping. They pointed big guns at me and the kids and yelled at us. They separated me from my kids and

threatened me. I kept asking to see a warrant and what I had done wrong. They never showed me any warrant and they never said I did anything wrong."





Berenice

"What they did was not right, especially because they had been in my apartment the day before and they found the kids with their grandmother. Why would they come back with even more officers, more guns, and late at night knowing the kids were there? They wanted to intimidate us because they thought they could. I want to show my

children that we stand up to things like this when they happen. I am glad we have filed this lawsuit because I want to help make sure this doesn't happen to other families, especially to other kids."
